OFFICE ORDER

No. 4724/Emg.

Consequent open revision of the enforcement guidelines of lockdown vide Order No. 2299/R&DM(DM) in Govt. of Odisha Dated. 25.04.2020 whereby there is substitution in Clause-1 at Sub-Clause-(ix) and addition after Sub-Clause-xiii of Clause-V of Order No. 2214, Dated. 17.04.2020 and whereby Collector & District Magistrate has been empowered to notify the details, in supersession of this officer Order No.4141/Emg. Dt.19.04.2020 the following order of implementation is passed in respect of the district of Jharsuguda to take immediate effect.

Rural

1. All the exemptions in-force hither to will continue as such in Rural area.
2. The timing for vending of vegetables, fish, egg, meat & other non-veg items will be between 6.00 AM to 11.00 AM. However locations will be dispersed and segregated as is the practice now. There will be orderliness among the customers to be ensured by the vendors for social distancing.
3. The grocery shops will remain open from 7.00 AM to 1.00 PM both in urban and rural area instead of 6.00 AM to 11.00 AM as notified earlier.
4. The shops as listed over leaf will remain open in rural areas from 9.00 AM to 6.00 PM except the places mentioned below which are treated urban-like.
5. Further no shopping mall if located in rural areas will be allowed to open. However the market complexes if housing the allowed shops will remain open.

Rural areas of exception (Urban-like)

Jharsuguda Block:- Beherepat revenue village of H.Katapali GP, Durlaga revenue village of Durlaga GP, Badmal revenue village of Badmal GP.

Lakhanpur Block:- OPGC front i.e. Telenpali revenue village of Telenpali GP, Bandhbahal Bazar of Bandhbahal GP.

Kolabira Block:- Kolabira block hqrs. Bazar & Samasingha Bazar of Kolabira GP.

Laikera Block:- Laikera Bazar of Laikara GP.

Urban & Urban-like

In the ULBs of Jharsuguda, Brajrajnagar & Belpahar and the places treated Urban-like the exemption and timing as allowed hither to will continue as such except the grocery shops which will remain open from 7.00 AM to 1.00 PM.

Vending of vegetables, eggs, chicken, mutton & other non-veg items will be between 6.00 AM to 11.00 AM.

No declared market complex will be allowed to open (different from Rural areas).

Eating joints Eateries, Road side vending of food items are strictly forbidden.

Illegal sale of wine and other excise materials will be dealt with strictly.

No shopping mall can deal with other things except grocery.

In case there are two adjacent shops dealing in the items allowed to be transacted now, these shops will remain open on alternative days in mutual arrangement which will be decided by our visiting squads (different from Rural areas). All these additionally allowed shop establishments both in Urban and Rural areas will remain open between 9.00 AM to 6.00 PM.

*Shops dealing with mobile cell phone (both repair and vending), IT equipment and Computer, variety store, Stationery Shops, Shops of Auto spare parts, Cycle parts and Motor tyre & tube, Establishments vending utensils of steel, Aluminum and other metals, Shops of Chemical matter, Street side open air shoes and garment vendors, Fabrication units, Photo Studios, Shops selling spectacles, Units of photo copying and Type-writers, Small furniture shops (not malls), Bakery / Ice-cream shops for home delivery only, Garages and Cycle repair shops. **However there will be no use of bike nor any other motorised vehicle unless it is for medicines and medical need.***


These establishments will run at 50 % of their staff strength. Solo running will be preferable. As regards in-position staff they are to satisfy the visiting squad and the police staff about their original and present strength. They will not sell anything to a customer not wearing mask. Required provision will be there for sanitization. Ovals and circles will be drawn in front of the shops for equidistancing the customers. The shops owners and the staff serving there mandatorily are to wear masks and wash their hands frequently with soap and sanitizer. They will not indulge in any malpractice of quoting inflated rates taking advantage of limited outlets. **Deviation will be viewed seriously and invite penal action under Disaster Management Act. and IPC.**




