OFFICE ORDER

No. 5292 /Emg.

Dated : 04.05.2020

Whereas it is incumbent upon the Disaster Management authority to bring out a district specific order or Regulations with a view to contain the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, consequent upon the publication of the Order No.2444/R&DM(DM) Dt. 03.05.2020 and in the context that period of lockdown stands extended till mid-night of 17.05.2020.

Whereas prohibition, restriction, regulation and permission for activities have been recast

Whereas the district of Jharsuguda vide Order No. 10546/H Dated. 03.05.2020 in Govt. of Odisha in Health & Family Welfare Department has been categorised "Orange" in consonance with the risk profile

Whereas the Collectors / Municipal Commissioners are authorised to calibrate their response and impose any further restriction needed in respect of the activities permitted in the order of Govt. of Odisha

Whereas para-11 of the order of Government prescribes some special stipulations in regard to timing for non-essential activity, regulated movement of the persons of old age & morbidity, expecting women and children below 10 years and OPD services in containment-zones the following are ordered for in respect of the district of Jharsuguda

Activities prohibited

- I. All domestic and international air travel of passengers, except for medical services, air ambulance and for security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
- II. All passenger movement by trains, except for security purposes or for purposes as permitted by MHA.
- III. Inter-State Buses for public transport, except as permitted by MHA.
- IV. Inter-State movement of individuals except for medical reasons or for activities as permitted by MHA.

- V. All schools, colleges, educational/ training/ coaching institutions, etc. However, online/ distance learning shall be permitted.
- VI. Hospitality services other than those used for housing health/ police/ Government officials/ healthcare workers, stranded persons including tourists, and those used for quarantine facilities.
- VII. All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, sports complexes, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars, auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.
- VIII. All social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions/ other gatherings.
- IX. All religious places/ places of worship shall be closed for public. Religious congregations are strictly prohibited.

Activities not permitted

- a. All that are prohibited.
- b. Inter-district & Intra-district plying of buses.
- c. Opening of shops dealing in the following :- (1) Clothing, (2) Jewellery, (3) Stitching & Tailoring, (4) Road side Eateries, Restaurants and Bars, (5) Liquor shops both ON & OFF, (6) Sale of Pan, Gutkha and Cigarette, (7) Saloon, Spa & Beauty parlor.

However the road side / footpath vendors vending cloth and dress materials will continue doing their business maintaining prescribed distance in between.

New activities permitted

- I. Activities and establishments allowed in this office Order No.4141/Emg. Dated. 19.04.2020.
- II. Taxis and cab aggregators, with 1 driver and 2 passengers only.
- III. Inter-district movement of individuals and vehicles, only for permitted activities. Four wheeler vehicles will have maximum two passengers besides the driver.
- IV. Central Govt. offices and PSUs all function as per the instruction of respective departments and MHA.
- V. State Govt. offices will function as per the order of Govt. in G.A. Department.

VI. Industries and Mines will remain operational with full strength observing norms of social distance and hygiene. However they will retain at least 75% of workers on the campus.

VII. All other activities with regulation of timing.

The establishments which did not enjoy exemption in the earlier order and not included in the 'not permitted category' of this order are allowed to operate. **The market complex in urban areas will remain open irrespective of ownership. However in case of 02 adjacent shops dealing in the allowed commodities / articles, they will open on alternative days which will be decided locally by the EOs in urban areas and BDOs in rural areas.** The officers, concerned need to do the exercise immediately in consultation with the Incident Commander of the area. For the purpose they may take the help local Chamber of Commerce or Shops Owners' Association if any.

Regulation with regard to timing

- I. The allowed shops and vendors will operate from **6.00 AM to 01.00 PM**. There will be no movement beyond **1.00 PM** except by the people permitted and having medical emergency.
- II. It is mandatory that persons above 65 years, people having morbidity, pregnant women and the children below 10 years shall stay indoor except for health purposes. Responsibility of keeping them indoor also lies with the family head.

Social Distancing

- I. Wearing of mask and social distancing everywhere is individual responsibility.
- II. Observance of physical gap and social distancing by the customers is the responsibility of the shop owners. Nothing will be sold to a visiting purchaser not wearing mask.
- III. Similarly there will be social distancing to be observed at all office establishments. The same is responsibility of heads of offices.

People not wearing mask and spitting in open will be fined by authorised officers.

Penal Provision

Deviation in conformity to the measures thus prescribed will invite action as per the provisions contained in Sec- 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act., Sec-188 of IPC, relevant provisions of Epidemic Disease Act-1897 and other legal prescriptions as Act. available.

The district specific order thus issued is only supplemental to the order of the State in so far it relates to implementation of Order No. 2444, Dated. 03.05.2020 of Special Relief Commissioner and the variation limited to form only (not in content) is as per the authority delegated to the undersigned.
