



**COVID-19 URGENT**

**ORDER**

No.5546/Emg.

Dated : 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020

Whereas order No.2444/R&DM(DM) Dated 03-05-2020 of the Govt. of Odisha issued under the signature of Chief Secretary in para No.7, sub-para 2(c) allowed other activities not specifically restricted in this phase of lockdown.

Whereas further in para No.10, District Collector(s)/Commissioner of Municipal Corporation(s) were required to continually assess the risk to public health and calibrate their response.

Now therefore in partial modification of this office order No.5292/Emg. Dt.4.5.2020 and without any prejudice to the prohibited activities dealt in Para-5 of the Order of Govt. of Odisha and para on the said subject in the Order No.5292/Emg Dt.4.5.2020 of the Collector & District Magistrate, Jharsuguda shops dealing in cloths, jewellery, stitching and tailoring, road side eateries, (mobile thelas) and small betel shops in the district of Jharsuguda are hereby taken out of the category of "Not Permitted" until further orders. Accordingly all shop establishments except Restaurants & Bars, liquor shops both ONN & OFF, Salon, Spa & Beauty Parlour, road side eateries in cluster will remain open in the district of Jharsuguda (Urban & Rural) from 6.00 AM to 1.00 PM. However, there will be no sale of Gutkha & Cigarettes in the Betel shops or at any other locations. The road side Trolleys, Thelas can vend food items at segregated and individual locations. Clusters say for example, the front space of OMP in Jharsuguda town and similar locations elsewhere in the district are banned.

All other stipulations relating to regulation and restriction as pronounced in this Office Order No.5292/Emg. Dt.4.5.2020 (a copy of which is enclosed) will remain in force. Two adjacent shops cannot remain open at the same time. They can transact business on alternative days by mutual understanding. Norms of social distancing, no sale to a purchaser without mask and conformity to the practices of sanitisation will be enforced without dilution.

Further private cab or auto on hire having maximum occupancy of two can operate. There will be no pillion ride in the motor cycles and two wheelers.

There will be no vehicular movement from 7.00 PM to 6.00 AM next day in the morning unless there is medical emergency and there is specific permission from appropriate authority.

**This order will take immediate effect. However this will have no implication for Containment and Buffer Zones of the district being regulated by specific orders.**
