

The Govt. of Odisha vide its Order no. 1164/R&DM(DM) dt 08.03.2021 having allowed celebration of Mahasivaratri on 11.03.2021 at the places of worship with restrictions to avoid large congregations/gatherings for the sake of containing the outbreak and spread of infection by new variant SARS-Cov-2 and the District Disaster Management Authority being empowered to stipulate customised restrictions the following guidelines are issued to apply to the occasion in the district of Jharsuguda.

- a. The gathering / congregations including entry, exit and assembly inside the bounded premises of the temple of Lord Shiva will be limited to 300 over a duration of 1 hour.
- b. Devotees can visit temples and worship following social distancing and by compulsory wearing of masks.
- c. **Mela/congregations** are prohibited.

The Tahasildars as incident Commanders are hereby authorised to implement the above restrictions in their respective jurisdictions.


Persons found violating this order shall be punished under the provisions of Disaster Management Act 2005 and other relevant laws.




