

2. The lowest eligible bidder, whose tender is accepted shall execute a notarized agreement on a non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs.100/- with the authority within 7 days from receipt of supply order to the effect that supply of all the items contained in the order shall be supplied by him/her in phased manner within 45 days after receipt of supply order ensuring quality as approved by the technical committee, failing which the order shall be cancelled forthwith. In such an instance the order shall be placed with the L2 bidder.
3. The bidders should not have been blacklisted or debarred from carrying on the business or should not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practice issued by Central Govt./ any State Govt.
4. The eligibility criteria can be changed / altered or relaxed by a duly constituted technical committee without assigning any reason thereof.






INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDDERERS WHILE OBTAINING TENDER PAPER

- i) Each set of Tender documents shall be serially numbered and each page thereof duly authenticated by initial signature of CDVO Jharsuguda, with rubber stamp affixed. The bidder should check the documents, in case he/she notices any lapse, he should immediately brought the same to the notice of CDVO Jharsuguda, for necessary rectification.
- ii) The Original money receipt obtained towards purchase of Tender Paper should be carefully preserved and should be enclosed in Original at the time of submission of tender Papers.

INSTRUCTIONS WHILE SUBMITTING THE TENDER PAPERS:

1. All Papers submitted with the bid along with the tender paper should bear the signature of the bidder in every page and super-scribing submitted by me.
2. Capital letters should be used in filling up of the tender form and should be neatly typed.
3. All corrections. Additions, alternations, in the tender documents shall be authenticated by initial /Signature of the bidder .Lapses in these instructions is liable for rejection of tender.
4. Rates should be quoted on the prescribed tender form. The rates offered should be written both in figures and in words. No erase or overwriting shall be entertained.
5. All information in these tender documents shall be in English only.
6. The bidder must quote the rates of the items for which they have been specifically asked for as per tender schedule. Tenderers quoting the rates or units different from those mentioned in the tender schedule may be liable for rejection. Tender containing clerical error /typographical error/arithmetical mistake(s) may be liable for rejection as well.
7. The tenderers shall quote the basic rates, which shall be inclusive of transportation charges up to the area specified for setting up of camp for quarantine purpose prior to the delivery of animal to the individual beneficiary. Animal brought in a lot shall be kept at the quarantine camp for 16 days at the cost of the tenderer . Identification and provision of camp location shall be facilitated by ARD department for exclusive quarantine purpose. No payment will be made towards the cost of animal died or discarded during quarantine period . Then farmer will receive the animal from camp after successful completion of quarantine period.
8. In quarantine center, the BVO/VAS of the concerned Block should be in charge of all technical activities. He will make a vigilance team of Veterinary Doctor and support staff to keep a close watch on health of the animals. The team will take prompt action to treat the animals in case of any sickness and provide all technical assistance required by supplier.

9. The supplier should allow to vaccinate all animals against PPR, Goat Pox and ENT, if not done earlier. If animals are vaccinated earlier, he should provide authentic documents of vaccination certified by registered veterinary doctor. Deworming of animals will also be done during quarantine period.
10. All the expenditure related to maintenance, deworming, vaccination and treatment of animals will be borne by supplier.
11. One rate shall be offered for one item. Submission of multiple rates against one item shall be considered a demerit. In case there are really different qualities to be offered against one item and all of them conform to the standard and specification of the required item more than one rate can be offered for consideration. But the Tenderer in all such cases shall clearly mention the specification for each item.
12. All the papers enclosed with the tender paper submitted by the proprietorship Firm should duly be signed by the sole Proprietor or his/her authorized representatives on whose favour the proprietor has issued the registered power of Attorney. A Copy of the registered power of attorney should be filed in support of the fact stated.
- Tender filled by a partnership firm shall be signed by the managing partner, manager of the firm or any other partner who has been specifically empowered to file the tender on behalf of the Firm. If there is no partner specifically empowered to do so, all the partners should sign the Tender documents. A copy of the partnership deed (Registered /Unregistered should be enclosed along with the Tender in support of the fact.
13. Submission of more than one Tender by a particular bidder under different names is strictly prohibited. In case it is discovered at a later stage that the mentioned condition is being violated in such an instance all the bid submitted by the firm would be rejected or cancelled in addition to recommend for legal action against the firm.



In case of failure to deliver any or all of the above stipulation CDVO, Jharsuguda after due adjudication of the matter is entitled to take such punitive action as suspending the vendors from execution of the program until the deficiencies are made good or for such time as may be decided by the CDVO, Jharsuguda debarring the vendor from supply of the animals and blacklisting the vendor from executing all projects implemented through CDVO, Jharsuguda-


