OFFICE ORDER

The Govt. of Odisha vide its Order no. 1339/R&DM(DM) dt 25.02.2022 having allowed celebration of Mahasivaratri on 01.03.2022 at the places of worship with restriction to avoid large congregations/gatherings for the sake of containing the outbreak and spread of COVID-19 and the District Disaster Management Authority being empowered to stipulate customised restriction/regulation the following guidelines are issued to apply to the occasion in the district of Jharsuguda.

1. The Priests as usual will perform the rituals.
2. Devotees are allowed for darshan and worship.
3. They can visit temples and worship following the norms of social distancing and by compulsory wearing of masks.
4. **Melas** are prohibited. This prohibitory order will be enforced strictly.

The Tahasildars as incident Commanders are hereby authorised to implement the order of regulation and prohibition in their respective jurisdictions.

Persons found violating this order shall be punished under the provisions of Disaster Management Act 2005 and other relevant laws. The liability for commission of offence will also rest upon the temple committees.


