GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITION

1. The bidders are expected to be fully conversant with the meaning of all the clauses of the tender before submission of the tenders.
2. All the tenders should be addressed by Designation to the Superintending Engineer, Rural Works Division, Jharsuguda.
3. The Intending Firms/Person may inspect the Old / Condemned / Unserviceable vehicles up to Dt. **17.12.2022** and satisfy themselves about the Quality of vehicles before offering their prices and no complaint will be entertained after wards. Inspection may be done between **11.00 AM to 5.00 PM** on working days with prior permission from the designated officer.
4. The amount should be quoted taking the entire quantity into account. All labour charges towards loading, unloading & transportation charges from the site to the destination point shall be borne by the successful bidder.
5. The rates should be written legibly both in words and figures and any correction, overwriting etc. should be avoided. In case of any discrepancies between the rate quoted in figure and words. Words will be taken into consideration. Correction where un-avoidable, should be made by rewriting with dated initial after scoring out the wrong entries.
6. Tender containing arithmetical and clerical mistakes will be liable for rejection.
7. Any request from the bidders in respect of addition, alternation, modifications or correction etc. in either terms and conditions or rates of the tender after submission of the tender will not be entertained.
8. For any other information or clarification, regarding the tender, the bidders may contact with the Superintending Engineer Rural Works Division, Jharsuguda before submission of the tender.
9. The tender Form/ paper is to be duly filled in and signed on each page of the tender documents. The tender schedule should be sent in "SEALED ENVELOPE" duly super scribed vehicle no with "Tender No 02 of 2022-23 for sale old condemned unserviceable vehicles as to reach on or before due date & time. The tenders received after due date & time fixed for receipt of the tender will not be considered in any case. No tender will be entertained in any other forms excepting the "Tender Schedule" issued along with the documents.
10. (a) The bidders are required to sign the undertaking in the proforma enclosed with the tender documents.
(b) One sealed envelope must be used for tender documents of one vehicle where as using of one sealed envelope for more than one vehicle is liable for rejection.
(c) The bidding value shall not be less than the offset price at any cost.
11. The bidders can also submit his tender by Registered Post / Speed Post so as to reach the Division Office within the stipulated date and time, but the authority will not be held responsible for any postal delay.
12. The decision of the competent authority accepting the tender will be final and binding on the bidders.
13. The tender will be considered valid for a period of 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening of the tender, confirmations regarding extension of validity will be asked from the bidders if further extension is required.
14. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT**
The E.M.D. @ 5 % of the upset price should be furnished along with the tender in shape of POSTAL SAVING PASS BOOK/ POST OFFICE TIME DEPOSIT ACCOUNT/TDR only duly pledged in favour of Superintending Engineer Rural Works Division, Jharsuguda payable at Jharsuguda along with the tender or otherwise it will be rejected. Request for adjustment of E.M.D. from any outstanding deposit or from the tender value will not be entertained.

15. GSTIN./I.T. C.C./PAN

GSTIN certificate, IT Clearance certificate and PAN are required to be attached with the tender failing which the tender will be liable for rejection.

16. Terms of payment and issue of release order for the auctioned sale of old condemned unserviceable vehicles.

- (a) The highest bidder has to deposit 25 % of the total bid amount in the same day with in office hour in shape of Demand Draft issued by a nationalize bank in favour of Superintending Engineer, Rural Works Division, Jharsuguda payable at Jharsuguda & balance amount of accepted tender should also be paid in shape of Demand Draft within 15 days from the date of issue of intimation of acceptance of the tender by the Superintending Engineer, Rural Works Division, Jharsuguda.
- (b) The quoted price in the tender is exclusive of GST. The successful bidder is to furnish the GST deposit receipt as applicable on the tender value of the materials from the concerned C.T.O. Jharsuguda.
- (c) **The release order for lifting the Old/Condemned / Unserviceable vehicles will be issued only after the clearance of the Demand Draft for the full amount as per accepted tender is deposited and GST deposit receipt is furnished within the scheduled time as in sub clause 9a) above.**

17. Lifting of auctioned old condemned unserviceable vehicles.

- (a) As far as possible, the old condemned unserviceable vehicles must be removed by the successful bidder himself or by his authorized agent duly authorized by him in writing on his behalf within 7 days from the date of issue of release order. The time of removal may be suitably extended by the competent authority to accept the tender taking into consideration for lifting of old condemned / unserviceable vehicles.
- (b) As soon as the full amount is paid by the successful bidder along with GST deposit receipt, he would acquire his lien on the materials. It will be his responsibility to look after such vehicles at his own expenses and the department will not be held responsible for any damage done by way of pilferage or any other unforeseen calamity and no claim on this account will be entertained.

18. Negotiations :-

The authority reserves the right to ask the bidder for negotiations.

19. Refund of E.M.D.

- (a) The E.M.D. for the accepted tenders will be refunded in full after the old condemned unserviceable vehicles are lifted.
- (b) The E.M.D. of all bidders except the successful bidders shall be refunded immediately after finalization of offer/negotiations. The E.M.D given by other two parties except one whose tender is accepted shall be refunded after deposit of the accepted tendered amount in full by the successful bidder.

20. Penalty :-

- (a) If the successful bidder fails to deposit full amount of his accepted tender and GST deposit receipt within 15 days from the date of issue of intimation of acceptance the E.M.D. as furnished earlier will be forfeited to the Government.
- (b) If the auctioned unserviceable vehicles are not lifted by the successful bidder, within prescribed period as at clause 17 (a) ground rents at the rate of 10 % of the accepted bid amount per day will be charged extra. In the event of the ground rent recoverable from the successful bidder exceeds the sales price deposited the purchaser will cease to have any lien of the auctioned unserviceable vehicles. The amount deposited towards sale price will be

24. Misrepresentation of facts as required in this case will lead to forfeiture of E.M.D. and rejection of tender.


25. Legal Dispute :-
