ORDER

No.6078/Emg.

Whereas the National Executive Committee vide Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) Dated.17th May,2020 of Govt. of India in Ministry of Home Affairs has issued directions to all the States and Union Territories for strict implementation of lockdown up to 31.05.2020 w.e.f. 18.05.2020 in order to contain the spread of COVID-19

Whereas Govt. of Odisha through the Special Relief Commissioner, in supersession of all previous orders related to the subject has extended the lockdown in the entire State of Odisha till midnight of 31.05.2020

Whereas the movement of individuals has been strictly prohibited between 7.00 PM to 7.00 AM (next day) except for essential activities

Whereas the District Collectors / Municipal Commissioners based on their assessment of the situation are authorised to prohibit such other activities in various zones or impose such restriction as deemed necessary

Now therefore it is incumbent upon the District Disaster Management Authority, Jharsuguda to bring out a specific order in modification of this office order No.5292/Emg. Dated.04.05.2020.

1. The lockdown as prescribed shall continue to remain in force up to the midnight of 31.05.2020.

2. **Activities prohibited**

The prohibition as prescribed in regard to different activities in Para-2 of the order of State will remain in force. A copy of the relevant page of the order of GoO is attached. However sports activities are allowed for sports persons and players without spectators. Players and children above 10 years can play out-door games maintaining proper social distancing and observing the parameters of sanitisation both during and following the conclusion of games.

3. **Permitted with restriction**

The following activities shall be permitted with restriction:

- i. Inter-state bus movement is conditional to decision of the state government.
- ii. Intra and Inter-district movement of two wheelers, private vehicles, official vehicles, taxis (including cabs by aggregators like Ola, Uber etc.) with the qualifiers as said below,

- a. Private Taxis and Autos can operate with maximum 02 passengers on board.
- b. There will be no pillion drive on two wheelers except in the cases of old (above 60 years), infirm, differently abled, women, children below 10 years and patients.

4. **Saving the vulnerable**

Persons above 65 years of age with co-morbidities, pregnant women, children below the age of 10 years shall stay at home except for essential and health purposes.

5. **Shop Establishments**

- i. All shop establishments allowed to operate in the previous orders will continue to do that.
- ii. Small saloons, small betel shops (not Gutkha and Cigarette) and restaurants with home delivery are also allowed to operate. However sale of Gutkha and Cigarette is strictly banned. The saloon will have arrangement for boiling the water to wash scissors and other accessories of hair dressing and shaving. The saloon owner is to also make use of rectified spirit for frequent washing of his tools. He will attend the customers carrying own towels / cloth for wrapping the body. Customers not carrying the same will not be entertained. Blade will be used once for one customer. Deviation will invite strict penal action including closure of the saloon.
- iii. Dhabas along the NH and SH which have been allowed to operate earlier will remain open for the convenience of the crew of goods' carriers.

In addition to the prohibited commercial establishments (Para-2 of the order of GoO) the shops which will continue to remain closed are : the liquor shop both ON and OFF, Restaurants and Bars, Road side Eateries in cluster, Spa and Beauty Parlour.

Timing

The shop establishments including restaurants for home delivery except the ones of vegetables, grocery and non-veg edibles will remain open from 7.00 AM to 5.00 PM. The sale of vegetables, grocery and non-veg edibles will be from 7.00 AM to 1.00 PM.

6. **Industries and Mining**

- i. Industrial activity and mining will be at full scale.
- ii. The industries will take adequate measures towards retaining 75% of their staff on the campus.
- iii. Discipline of social distancing and sanitisation will be adhered to on the premises of Industries and Mining Establishments.
- iv. **Instances of violation by industrial houses and mining companies both ON and OFF campus shall be considered as offence and the persons in-charge of the unit to conduct business of the company shall be deemed to be guilty of the contravention and liable to be prosecuted U/s-58 of the Disaster Management Act-2005.**

Explanation

- i. Company means anybody corporate and includes a firm or other associations of individuals.
- ii. 'Persons responsible' mean Directors, Managers, Secretary or any other Officer having a role in decision making.

7. **All activities allowed earlier in the manners as prescribed will continue.**

8. **Strict regulation in movement**

- i. The movement of individuals between 7.00 PM to 7.00 AM (next day) is strictly prohibited except for essential activities and medical emergency. The goers and returnees to and from different industrial and mining establishments in the night schedule will have exemption from this prohibition. However they have to produce Identity Cards issued by the Employers or Passes given by the appropriate authorities. Their to & fro travel will have reference to the work schedule and accordingly they will be permitted only. As provision of Section-144 of Cr.PC will be in force throughout the district from 7.00 PM to 7.00 AM (next day) the person / party permitted to move in these hours will have to give proof of their identity. Separate order for promulgation of Section-144 of Cr.PC will follow.
- ii. **Zoning**: Zoning of different areas in the district looking at the intensity of risk will be done later at appropriate time keeping in view the prescribed parameters. Decisions regarding containment and buffer zones will be guided by the appropriate guidelines of Govt. of India and Govt. of Odisha.

9. **Social Distancing**

- i. Wearing of masks and social distancing everywhere is individual responsibility.
- ii. Observance of physical gap and social distancing by the customers is the responsibility of the shop owners. Nothing will be sold to a visiting purchaser not wearing mask.
- iii. Similarly there will be social distancing to be observed at all office establishments. The same is responsibility of heads of offices.

People not wearing mask and spitting in open will be fined by authorised officers.

10. **Penal Provision**

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be prosecuted under the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act-2005, besides facing legal action under sec-188 of the IPC, and other provisions as applicable.

2. The following activities shall continue to remain prohibited throughout the State:

- i. All domestic and international air travel of passengers, except for domestic medical services, domestic air ambulance and for security purposes or purposes as permitted by MHA.
- ii. Schools, colleges, educational/ training/ coaching institutions etc. will remain closed. Online/ distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged.
- iii. Hotels, restaurants and other hospitality services, except those meant for housing health/ police/ Government officials/ healthcare workers/ stranded persons including tourists and for quarantine facilities; and running of canteens at bus depots, railway stations and airports. Restaurants shall be permitted to operate kitchens for home delivery of food items.
- iv. All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.
- v. Sports complexes, stadia and other facilities will be permitted to open. Sports activities are allowed for sportspersons and players; however, spectators will not be allowed.
- vi. All social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions/ other gatherings and large congregations.
- vii. All religious places/ places of worship shall be closed for public. Religious congregations are strictly prohibited.
