Anganwadi Centres under ICDS Kirmira (List Enclosed) of which shall confirm to the terms and conditions (**Annexure-I**) for use in the Anganwadi Centres under ICDS Kirmira. The undersigned shall have the right to cancel the quotation at any time without stating any reason.

- 1) The Buckets should be durable, often galvanized mild steel buckets (typically 9-10L) used for sand/water, adhering to standards like IS 2546, featuring a leak-proof hemispherical bottom, strong handles (top & side), wired beaded rim, and distinct red/white/black painting with "FIRE" marked for easy identification, ensuring anti-corrosion treatment and robust construction for emergency fire response.
- 2) The fire blanket should be with features like material (typically fiberglass), size (e.g., 6 feet x 4 feet), temperature resistance (often 550°C+), thickness (around 0.43mm+), weight (GSM), and certification (like EN 1869:1997, IS 11871) and all other features required for fire safety focusing on smothering fires by cutting oxygen, being asbestos-free, and easily deployable for kitchen or industrial use. Key performance indicators include low shrinkage, flame time, and glow time, with options for silicone coatings or Kevlar stitching for enhanced durability.

1) The Buckets should be durable, often galvanized mild steel buckets (typically 9-10L) used for sand/water, adhering to standards like IS 2546, featuring a leak-proof hemispherical bottom, strong handles (top & side), wired beaded rim, and distinct red/white/black painting with "FIRE" marked for easy identification, ensuring anti-corrosion treatment and robust construction for emergency fire response.
