Sealed tenders will be received by Dated-18.04.2026 up to 5:00 PM. by the Chief District Medical & Public Health Officer, Jharsuguda through Speed Post/Regd.Post /courier only (not by hand) for supply, installation, operation of Digital Health & Wellness Diagnostic Kiosks for Rural CHC Jharsuguda. Any tender received further the due date & time will be rejected / returned to the sender unopened.

1. A pre-bid meeting shall be held on 08.04.2026 at 03:30 PM for any clarification of the bidder.
2. The bidder(s) shall have to submit their tender in separate sealed envelopes, i.e one for technical bid by superscribing Cover“A”(Technical Bid) & Cover“B”(Price Bids).The Technical Bid and Price Bids should be put into a third Cover, which should be super scribed as “Tender for supply, installation, operation of Digital Health & Wellness Diagnostic Kiosks for Rural CHC Jharsuguda vide Tender No:- 1008/NHM/26”for CDM & PHO, Jharsuguda”.
3. The Sealed tenders“Cover A” (Technical Bid) submitted by the tenderers will be opened at the O/O chamber of CDM& PHO, Jharsuguda on date-18.04.2026 at 11:30 AM. The tenderer or their duly authorized representative is allowed to be present during the opening of the tenders if they so like. No tender documents shall be accepted after the expiry of scheduled date and time for receipt of bids. The details of items and specification are mentioned at Annexure–A.
4. The GST shall be charged as per the guidelines given by the Finance Dept., Govt. of Odisha / India from time to time. All the payments are to be made through Treasury/ PFMS mode to the concerned party.
5. The decision of the Purchase committee is final and reserves all rights to go for quality testing of the goods prior to release of payments.
6. Keeping in view the budget provision the quality may not be compromised.
7. The door step delivery/installation (any health facility of the district) of the goods / materials has to be taken care of by the bidders without any extra payments for the same.
8. The door step delivery/installation of the goods/ materials has to be taken care of by the bidders without any extra payments for the same.
9. The prices quoted must be inclusive of all charges & freight if any but exclusive of GST. **Quoted rate should be maximum up to 2 decimals only.**



10. The rate will be applicable for purchase of the above-mentioned items for the period of one year and may be extended for a further period after due approval from the Authority.
11. The bidders have to maintain office decorum during the opening and finalization of the tender otherwise the purchase committee will take its own decision as deemed proper initiating from the instant cancellation of the concerned bidder.
12. During opening of tender only bidder himself or his authorized representative will be allowed to remain present. No authorized representative is allowed without proper authorization letter from bidder with ID Proof.
13. The time line of finalization of tender may vary or extend depending upon the emergency/ exigency of demand of the situation if any.
14. Incomplete tender shall be rejected and the undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
15. All legal disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Jharsuguda Court only.
16. The bill shall be processed only against a valid supply order. The L1(lowest) bidder shall not impose any preconditions regarding the fixation of specific quantities or supply commitments outside the scope of the tender. The quantity to be order shall be as per the actual requirement and the successful bidder is bound to supply the ordered quantity accordingly. Failure by L1 bidder to comply with the supplies order or refusal to delivery as per the specified requirement shall result in termination of their contract. In such a case, all the order may be placed to the L2(Second lowest) bidder with L1 rate and L1 bidder will be barred from receiving any further order under this contract or future tender also.
17. During the entire tender process, up to and including the finalization of the contract, no bidder shall have the right to request or access the bidding documents submitted by other bidders. The Tender Authority shall not be held liable for any inadvertent or unauthorized disclosure of any bidder's documents during the course of the tender process.

**A. Tender Processing Fee and EMD:**

1. The **Tender processing fee** (non-refundable) of **Rs.5,000/-** should be furnished by the Tenderers in shape of **Bank Draft** in favour of **"ZSS NON NRHM FUND AC"** and **payable at Jharsuguda** from any nationalized bank along with bid for verification.
2. The tenderer shall submit EMD of **Rs.1,00,000/-** in shape of **Bank Draft** in favour of **"ZSS NON NRHM FUND AC"** and **payable at Jharsuguda** from any nationalized bank as per the details mentioned below:

19. Service Support Escalation Matrix

20. Bidder or Authorised Re-seller office Presence in Odisha

21. OEM Trademark Certificate

The OEM must submit a valid Trademark Registration Certificate issued by the Controller General of Patents, Designs & Trademarks (India) for the offered product or brand.

**C. Delivery, Installation & Commissioning**

1. Supply, Installation, Commissioning and Training must be completed within 30 days from date of Work Order.
2. The quoted price must include: Transportation, Loading/unloading, Installation charges & Insurance, labour and statutory levies
3. Any equipment damaged or lost during transit or installation shall be replaced within 15 days at no extra cost.
4. The Procuring Authority may demand submission of a sample / demo unit at any stage of the bid process (during or after Technical / Financial evaluation or bid opening) for verification of specifications and performance. The sample shall be provided at the bidder's own cost within the time specified. Failure to comply may result in rejection of the bid.
5. The CDM & PHO, Jharsuguda reserves the right to accept/reject any bid or cancel the tender without assigning any reason.

**D. Warranty, Training & Documentation**

1. Minimum 3 Years onsite comprehensive warranty shall be provided including all accessories (All costs for 3 years).
2. The bidder shall provide: User Training, Basic Maintenance Training & Hard & Soft Copy Training Manuals.
3. The supplier shall provide: User Manual, Technical & Service Manual, Calibration & Maintenance Procedure & System Diagrams.

**E. Legal & Statutory**

1. All disputes shall be subject to Jharsuguda jurisdiction only.
2. All products shall comply with Indian laws including CDSCO, ISO and IT Act data security regulations.

**F. Pricing of the products: -**

**1. Deployment of Trained operator / LT:-**

- a. The bidder shall be responsible for deployment and supply of qualified and trained manpower / LT for operation and maintenance of the Health Kiosk for a period of three (3) years from the date of commissioning.
- b. The bidder shall quote monthly rates per HR (Minimum-01) (inclusive of all statutory compliances such as PF, ESIC, insurance, applicable taxes, etc.).
- c. The deployed manpower must meet the minimum qualification and experience criteria as prescribed by the Authority. The bidder shall ensure uninterrupted availability of manpower during the contract period, failing which penalties as per tender conditions shall be applicable. The Trained HR / Manpower deployed will have to stay at the installation site / CHC (HRA will be paid by the agency).

**2. Supply of Consumables: -**

- a. The bidder shall be responsible for the supply, replenishment, and maintenance of all

consumables required for the continuous and efficient functioning of the Health Kiosk throughout the contract period.

- b. The bidder shall ensure that adequate inventory of consumables is maintained at all times to avoid any disruption in services. All consumables supplied shall conform to the quality standards prescribed by the Authority or relevant regulatory bodies. The installed Diagnostic Kiosk and Test reports must cater to the OPD load of the CHC.

### **G. Evaluation:**

1. Tenders will be evaluated as per the requirement of the bid and the price bid (Cover-B) shall be opened only for the bidders who will qualify in the technical evaluation.
2. The cost of the unit item excluding Taxes / GST will be evaluated but including all type of charges.
3. If the approved lowest eligible supplier fails to supply ordered items within the stipulated period, to meet the need, the tender inviting authority reserves right to procure the same from the participated bidders at L1 rate, if they agree to supply at L1 approved rate.
