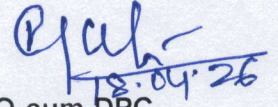

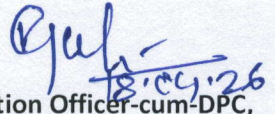

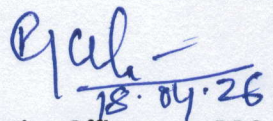

3. Back ground Information

The Collector & District Magistrate, Jharsuguda proposes to implement education technologies in **50 (fifty) Secondary Schools** on a pilot basis, with the aim of integrating best practices into the schooling ecosystem. This initiative seeks to enhance the overall teaching-learning experience and enable students to receive holistic educational inputs within their own schools through the effective use of technology. The primary objective of the project is to facilitate improved conceptual understanding among students through engaging and interactive digital content, including **AR (Augmented Reality) and VR (Virtual Reality)** platforms, thereby making learning more effective, immersive, and efficient.

The District Project Coordinator, Samagra Shiksha (DPC, SS), Jharsuguda has been designated as the implementing agency for finalizing the procurement process. In this context, on behalf of the District Administration, DPC, SS, Jharsuguda invites proposals from eligible and qualified bidders for the **design, supply, installation, commissioning, and maintenance of Virtual Classrooms with Digital Assessment Solutions**, including the required hardware, software, and associated services, across 50 Secondary Schools.

4. Basic Information

In order to provide high-quality educational support to students, the District Project Coordinator, Samagra Shiksha (DPC, SS), Jharsuguda intends to establish **AR-VR Labs with Digital Assessment Systems** in **50 (fifty) Secondary Schools**.

The selected Bidder shall be responsible for providing a **comprehensive end-to-end solution**, which includes the **design, supply, installation, integration, connectivity, commissioning, and Operations & Maintenance (O&M)** of the entire system. The scope shall also include instructional support and necessary training for effective utilization of the solution.

The Bidder shall provide an integrated **application software platform** for VR Classrooms, enabling efficient **content management, delivery, and digital assessment**. The proposed solution must be an **AR-VR integrated system**, specifically designed to function effectively in a classroom environment.

The system shall be **teacher-controlled**, preferably through a **tablet-based interface**, wherein all operational controls remain with the teacher during classroom sessions. The tablet shall be seamlessly connected with **10 (ten) VR devices per classroom** through a **dedicated local network / router**, ensuring smooth synchronization, centralized control, and uninterrupted content delivery within the classroom environment.

The entire solution must be robust, scalable, user-friendly, and suitable for regular academic use in school settings.

6. General Conditions for Eligibility & Evaluation

- In the absence of compliance with any of the above eligibility criteria, the bid shall be treated as **non-responsive** and shall be **summarily rejected**.
- All relevant supporting documents as specified against each eligibility criterion must be **submitted along with the Technical Bid**, failing which the bid shall be liable for rejection.
- The **financial and technical experience** of only the **bidding entity** shall be considered. The experience and credentials of **subsidiary / group / holding companies shall not be considered**.
- The Bidder must compulsorily submit **Manufacturer's Authorization Forms (MAF)** from the respective OEM(s) for the proposed **AR-VR Lab equipment and related components**.
- Bidders meeting the **pre-qualification criteria** shall be invited for a **Live Demonstration** of the proposed solution.

- The Live Demonstration shall form an integral part of the **technical evaluation process**. In case the Bidder fails to successfully demonstrate the proposed solution as per requirements, the Bidder shall be **disqualified**.
- The **Financial Bid** of only those Bidders who successfully qualify in the **Technical Evaluation, including Live Demonstration**, shall be opened.
- All Bidders shall submit an Undertaking on their official letterhead confirming that the proposed solution is fully ready for demonstration. The Bidder must also confirm their readiness to conduct a live demonstration as per the requirement of the authority at DPC, SS, Jharsuguda with 04 /05 nos. of sets. Failure to submit such undertaking or inability to demonstrate the proposed solution as specified shall be construed as the Bidder's offer being incomplete and non-responsive, and the bid shall be liable for rejection.

7. Instruction to Bidders

(a). General

- a) While every effort has been made to provide comprehensive and accurate background information, requirements, and specifications in this RFP, the Bidders are advised to **form their own independent assessment and conclusions** regarding the solution required to meet the project objectives. Bidders may consult their own **legal, technical, and financial advisors** with respect to this RFP.
- b) All information, documents, and submissions provided by the Bidders shall be deemed to be **contractually binding** upon them, in the event of award of the assignment by DPC, SS, Jharsuguda based on this RFP.
- c) This RFP **supersedes and replaces all prior communications, correspondences, and public documents**, whether written or verbal, issued in relation to this project. Bidders are advised **not to rely on any such previous communications**.

(b). Availability of RFP Document

- a) The availability of bidding documents shall be commenced from the date as mentioned in Notice Inviting Bids(NIB).The complete bidding document can be downloaded from the official District website of Jharsuguda <https://Jharsuguda.odisha.gov.in>,The prospective bidders are requested download the bidding document from the websites and follow the bidding steps as prescribed.
- b) The Bid Notice is also published in two leading newspapers (Odia) and one English for wide Circulation.

(c). Compliant Proposals/Completeness of Response

- a) Bidders are advised to study all instructions forms, terms, requirements, and other information in the RFP documents carefully. Submission of the bid shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the RFP document with full understanding of its implications.
- b) Failure to comply with the requirements set out in this RFP may render the Proposal non-compliant and the Proposal may be rejected. Bidders must include all documentation specified in this RFP.
- c) Follow the format and respond to each element in the order as set out in this RFP. Comply with all requirements as set out within this RFP.

(d). Period of Validity of Bids

- (a). Bids submitted by the bidders shall remain valid for a period of 180 Days from the date of submission of RFP.
- (b). Prior to the expiry of the period of validity of Bids, the procuring entity, in exceptional circumstances, may request the bidders to extend the bid validity period for an additional specified period. A bidder may refuse the request and such refusal shall be treated as withdrawal of Bid and in such circumstances bid security shall not be forfeited.
- (c). Bidders who agree to an extension of the period of validity of their bids shall extend or get extended the period of validity of bid securities submitted by them or submit new bid securities to cover the extended period of validity of their bids. A bidder whose bid security is not extended, or that has not submitted a new bid security, is considered to have refused the request to extend the period of validity of its Bid.

- a) All the Bids submitted by the bidders must be submitted with the checklist.
- b) Each page of the bidding document shall be kept with the office seal and signature by the authorized representative from the Bidder.

(G) Cost & Language of Bidding

- a) The bidder shall be responsible for all costs incurred in connection with participation in the bid process, including site visits but not limited to, costs incurred in conduct of informative and other diligence activities, participation in meetings/ discussions / presentations, preparation of bid, in providing any additional information required by DPO to facilitate the evaluation process, and in negotiating definitive contractor all such activities related to the bid process. (N) With drawal, Substitution, and Modification of Bids

- a) No proposal may be modified / withdrawn in the interval between the last date of submission of proposals/tender and the expiration of the validity period specified in the tender documents by the tendering authority.

(O) Bid Opening & Evaluation Procedure

- a) The Bids shall be opened by the **District Technical Committee (DTC)** in the presence of the Bidders or their duly authorized representatives who choose to attend.
- b) The Committee may **co-opt subject matter experts or experienced personnel** to assist in the Bid opening and evaluation process, if required.

In case the tendering process / public procurement process has not been completed within the stipulated period, DPO may like to request the bidders to extend the validity period of the bid. The notification of award will constitute the formation of the contract. Upon the successful bidder's furnishing of Performance Bank Guarantee, DPO will notify each unsuccessful bidder and return their EMD within 15 days.

Language:
